Gerry is a consultant advisor on climate change, energy and environment issues and has provided strategic advice to governments, industry and research organisations involved in development of low emission energy strategies, including renewable energy and carbon capture and storage. Until mid 2007 he was a senior executive in the Australian Greenhouse Office of the Australian Government where he was responsible for high level policy and program advice to Federal Ministers on climate change, energy and industry issues.

He was an Australian representative to the Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change, led the Commonwealth Coastal Taskforce and was a member of the CSIRO Energy and Transport Sectoral Advisory Council. He has held positions with international organisations including Co-Chair of the Asia Pacific Partnership Renewable Energy and Distributed Generation Taskforce, Co-chair of the Torres Strait Environment Management Committee and Head of business liaison and communications in the United Nations Secretariat for the 2002 World Summit on Sustainable Development.
