

Itinerary for **SEGRA** Study Tour - Events in Regional Australia: the Bathurst story



This study tour will take you through the Mount Panorama Precinct and highlight all the facilities that come under this banner, and it is not just motor racing.

With a focus on sporting events in the region, we will touch on not only the economic impact of the Supercheap Auto Bathurst 1000, but other events that take place within the precinct. Currently the Mount is home to the Liqui-Moly Bathurst 12 Hour in February, The Bathurst Motor Festival at Easter and the Supercheap Auto Bathurst 1000 in October.

2016 will see two new events come under the Council's events team; The 2016 National BMX Championships and the NAB Blayney to Bathurst Cyclo Sportif Challenge.

The tour will start in the Mayoral Suite at the Pit Complex followed by morning tea at the Bathurst Harness Racing Club. A bus tour will take in the Mount Panorama Precinct which includes the new world class BMX track which is under construction in the Bathurst Bike Park. The morning will finish with a tour and lunch at the historic Abercrombie House, hosted by Christopher Morgan, a local historian and owner of Abercrombie House.

9:40am – 10:00am	Morning Tea at the Mayoral Suite at Mount Panorama or at the Bathurst Harness Racing Club
10:00am	Commence a guided tour on the bus of the Mount Panorama Precinct which will include the track , the Bathurst Harness Racing Club, the Bathurst Bike Park which includes a first class BMX track and velodrome
11:15am	Head out to the Historic Abercrombie House for a tour and lunch on the grounds
12:45pm	Collect tour and head back to CSU to arrive by 1pm
